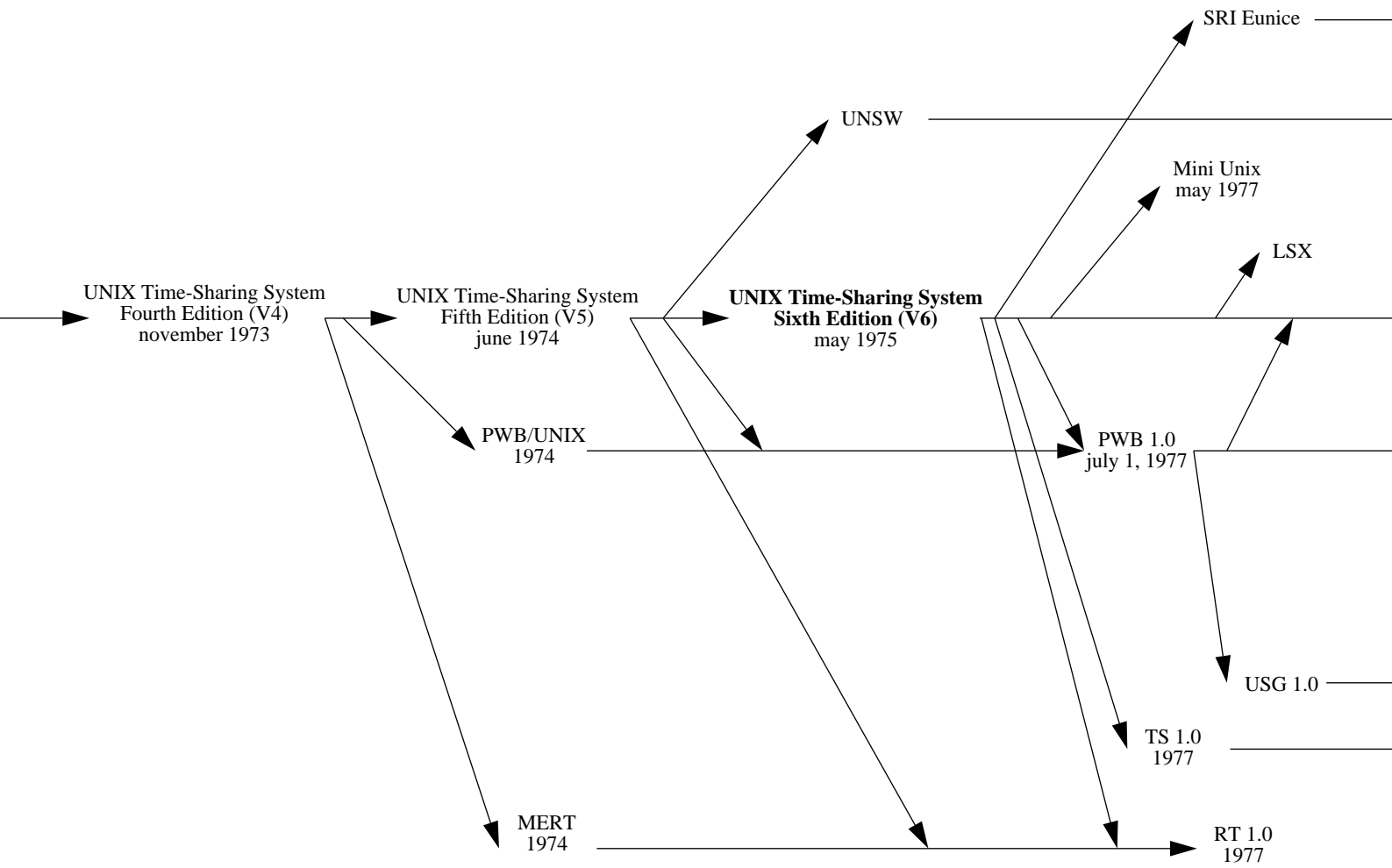

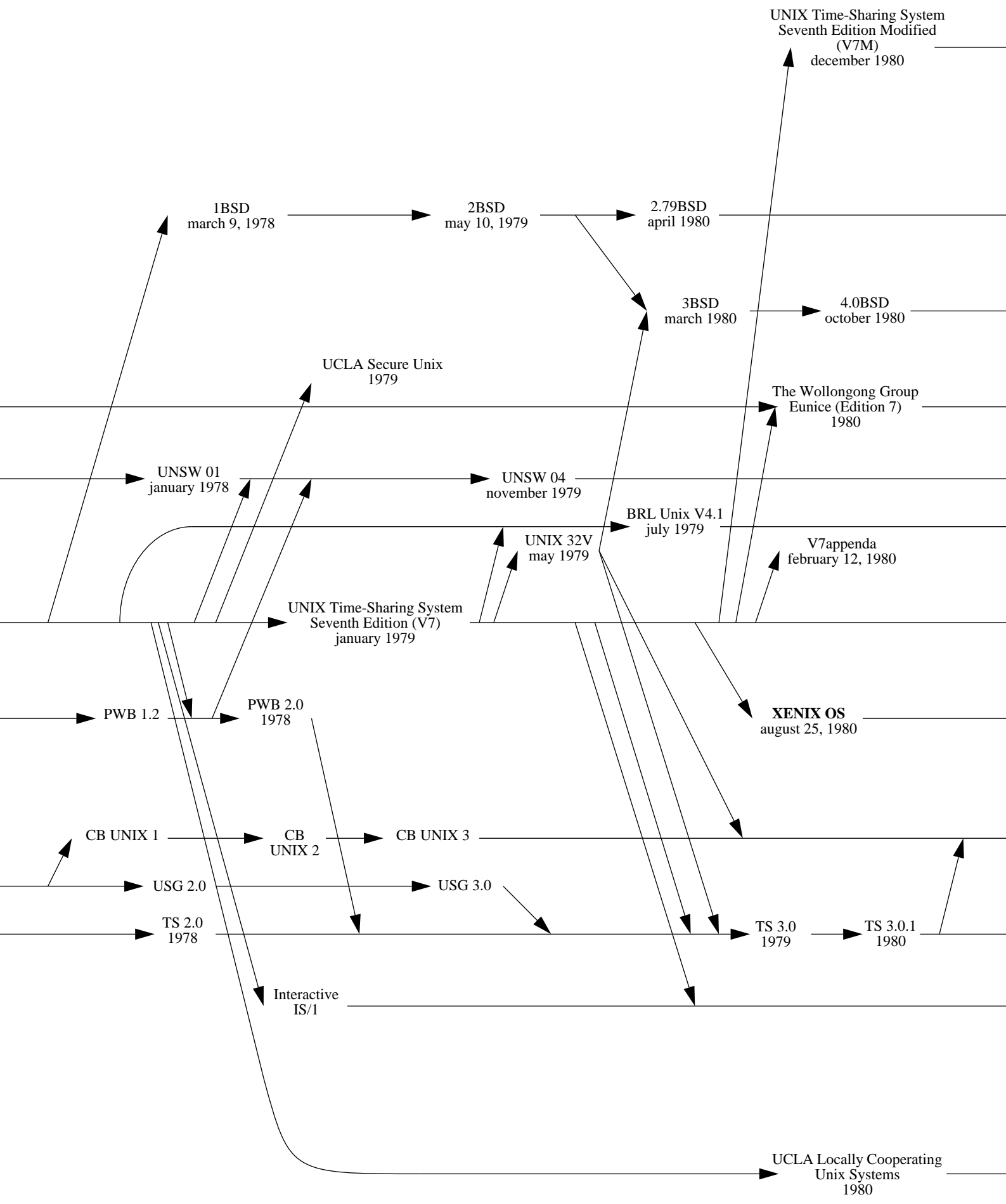

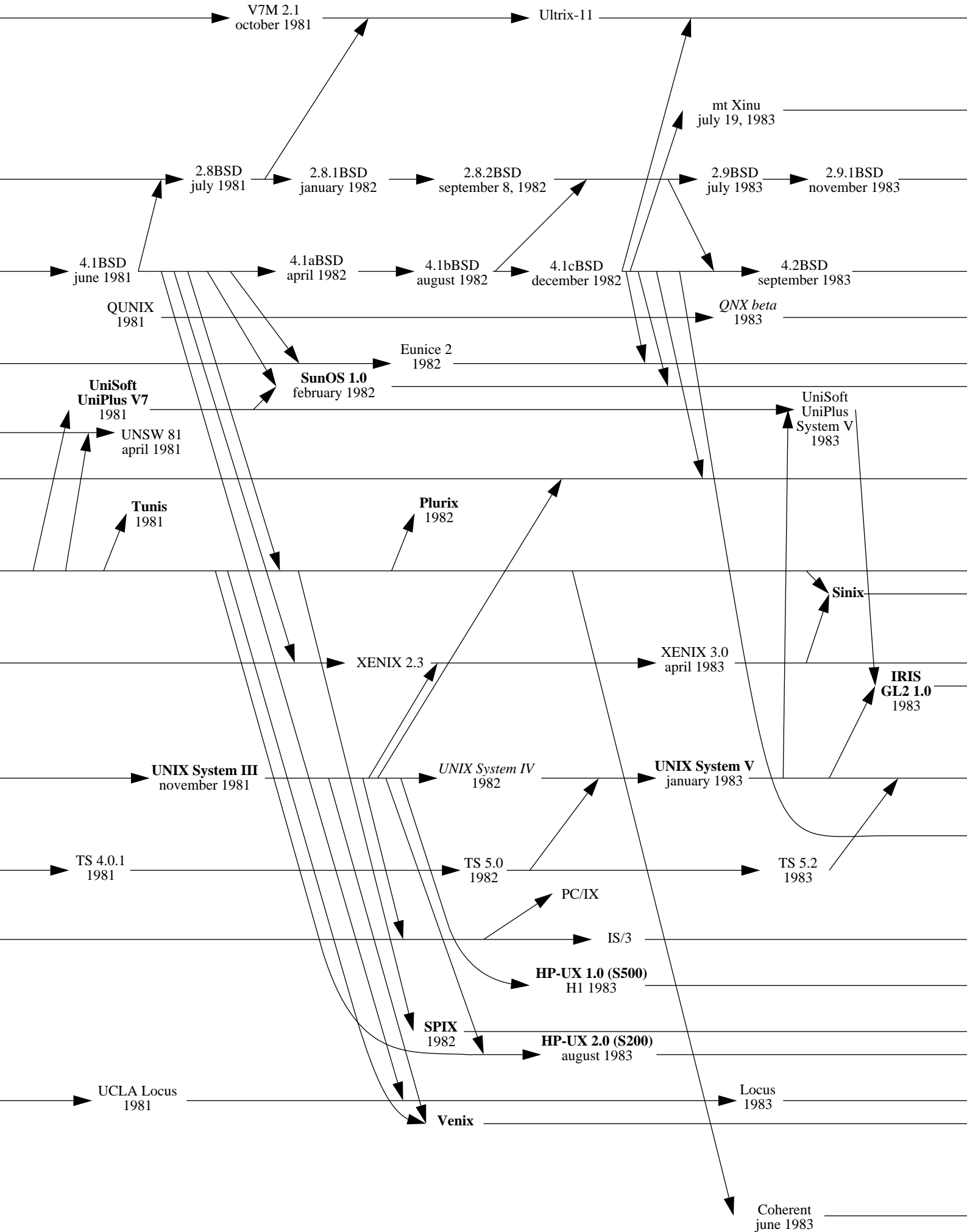
Note 1: an arrow indicates an inheritance like a compatibility, it is not only a matter of source code.
